## Post-Event Report | 2019 Summary

**The FTTH Council Asia-Pacific held the 14th Annual FTTH APAC Conference in Wuhan, China on 15-17 April 2019.**

**This year's conference theme was "5G Smart Cities Enabled by Fiber" and was an ideal opportunity to explore how the Asia Pacific telecom industry is continuing its deployment of FTTx and deep fiber to the network edge as a converged platform, from which Smart Cities and 5G networks can be built.**

The conference attracted around 400 senior executives from the region's telecom regulators, policy makers, network operators, municipal leaders and solutions providers; and offers an unrivalled opportunity to network and secure new business with hard-to-reach decision-makers.

Wuhan offered a fitting location for this year's focus, as the city hosts some of the world's leading optical communications companies and the region is dubbed "China's Optical Valley" and is well known as a hub for telecom technologies.

The conference was opened by Venkatesan Babu, President, FTTH Council Asia-Pacific. Mr. Babu delivered a welcoming speech and said the meeting



would provide a platform for industry leaders to share their strategic insights on 5G deployment and this is a opportunity to explore FTTx and other deep fiber deployment success stories. He also stressed that the deployment of FTTH in the region has come at a critical period.

The Council was welcomed to the city by Yang Lixiang, Director General, Bureau of Economic Information of Wuhan. The president of YOFC, Zhuang Dan, attended the opening ceremony and delivered a keynote speech. By summing up the achievements of the construction of FTTH and mobile carrier networks in the construction of China's broadband optical network.
